



Is Your Child Entitled to Free School Meals & A Uniform Grant

If so, to qualify parents must be in receipt of one of the following benefits

- Income Support
- Job Seekers Allowance (Income based)
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Child Tax Credit or Pension Credits with Child Tax Credit and have an annual income of less than 16,040
- Assisted by the National Asylum Support Service (NASS)

Please also remember if your son/daughter is receiving free school meals at the moment, your expiry date is due to end 23rd July 2010 so please renew or re-apply for the next Academic School Year 2010/11 you can either apply at the school where I will be happy to support you with your application or you can contact Pupil Support Services at your Local Authority.

Uniform Grant

If you are entitled to a uniform grant only children in reception and Year groups 3,5,7,9 will be eligible for assistance. To qualify parents must be in receipt of one of the following:

- Income Support
- Job Seekers Allowance (Income based)
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Incapacity benefit
- Pension Credit with Child Tax Credit and have an annual income of less than £16,040.
